II. Review ELPAC and Reclassification Data

A. ELPAC

1. ELPAC Review

Ray Banaag, ELD Regional coach, spoke about the upcoming ELPAC tests and what OFY-VV is doing to support ELL students for the test.

2. Testing Dates

Mr. Banaag gave parents and students in attendance the ELPAC testing dates and gave parents resources to help their students from the ELPAC website, including practice tests.

B. STAR RENAISSANCE

1. STAR RENAISSANCE Review

Mr. Banaag presented to committee the Star Renaissance test and how the test is used to help ELL reclassify.

2. Reclassification Qualifying Scores

Parents and people in attendance were then presented with the new score scale used by Renaissance Learning and what the qualifying scores ELL students need to be considered as English proficient.

C. Reclassification Data

1. Qualifications for Redesignation (RFEP)

Mr. Banaag reviewed the criteria for the redesignation of ELL students. The criteria included achievement of an overall score of a 4 on the ELPAC test, a qualifying score on the StarRen Reading test, Teacher observation of the student, and parent consultation.

2. Reclassification Data

Reclassification data was shared. OFY-VV had a reclassification rate of 73% in 2022, 83% in 2023, and 95% in 2024.

III. School Attendance

A. School attendance data

Mr. Banaag shared the school attendance data for OFY-VV. Overall the students at OFY-VV have shown 41% chronic absenteeism and ELL students have shown a 45% chronic absenteeism rate.

B. Importance of School Attendance

Mr. Banaag presented parents with resources to help their students with attendance. Resources include parent access to Studentrac, meetings with student's teachers, and free bus transportation through Victor Valley Transit.

IV. English Language Development Master Plan

A. Master Plan

1. Review

Mr. Banaag reviewed the ELD Master Plan to the DELAC. The ELD Master Plan is designed by the school to outline the instruction and supports that are provided to English Language Learners. The Master Plan includes goals, methods, and resources needed to effectively help English Learner students develop their English language proficiency.

V. Public Input

Mr. Banaag opened the meeting for anyone to give comments and feedback about anything discussed at the meeting. No public input was given at this time.
