

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR  
OPTIONS FOR YOUTH-VICTOR VALLEY, INC.**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Options for Youth-Victor Valley, Inc. (“Corporation”), a California nonprofit public benefit corporation that operates a public charter school, tentatively approved a Conflict of Interest Code (“Code”) pursuant to Government Code section 87300 at its meeting on January 24, 2025, and intends to finally adopt the Code. Pursuant to Government Code sections 87200 and 87302, the Code will designate public officials, employees, and consultants of Corporation who make governmental decisions and who, therefore, must disclose certain investments, interests in real property, sources of income, and business positions, and disqualify themselves from making or participating in the making of governmental decisions affecting those interests.

A public comment period has been established commencing on **February 14, 2025**, and terminating on **April 1, 2025** (a 45-day period). Any interested person may present written comments concerning the proposed Code during the public comment period to Corporation’s representative at the address listed below. No public hearing on this matter will be held unless any interested person or his or her representative requests a public hearing no later than 15 days prior to the close of the written comment period.
